

WEBSITE PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Sebring anticipates applying for Rebuild Florida Critical Facility Hardening Program (CFHP) funding provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to support long-term mitigation efforts by assisting the State of Florida and its local governments in minimizing or eliminating the risks and reducing losses from future disasters. This program is being administered by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) thru the Community Development Block Grant – Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) Program. A total of seventy-five million dollars (\$75,000,000.00) in funding has been allocated by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for the Rebuild Florida Critical Facility Hardening Program. DEO has identified the following types of structures as critical facilities:

- Potable water facilities;
- Waste water facilities;
- Police departments;
- Fire departments;
- Hospitals;
- Emergency operation centers; and
- Emergency shelters.

The City of Sebring anticipates applying for a total of two million three hundred fifty-nine thousand nine hundred forty-nine dollars (\$2,359,949.00) in funding through the CDBG-MIT Critical Facility Hardening Program.

Activities that are typically eligible for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program as well as specific additional activities as outlined in the State of Florida CDBG-MIT Action Plan for the program are eligible projects if no other funding is available to meet the need. Applications are due in DEO no later than June 30, 2020.
